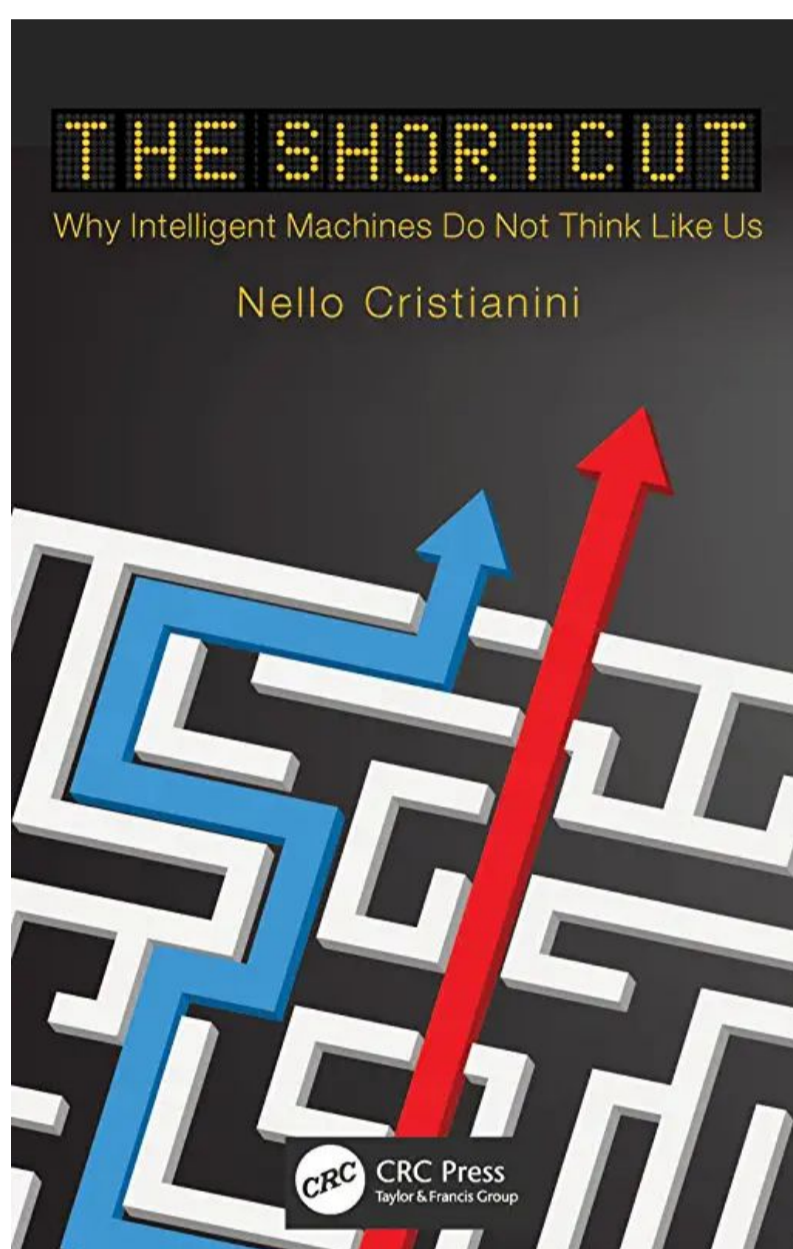

Presentation of the book:

"The Shortcut: why intelligent machines do not think like us"



Abstract. A particular form of AI is now embedded in our tech, our infrastructure, and our lives. How did it get there? Where and why should we be concerned? And what should we do now? The book "Shortcut: Why Intelligent Machines Do Not Think Like Us" provides an accessible yet probing exposure of AI in its prevalent form today, proposing a new narrative to connect and make sense of events that have happened in the recent tumultuous past, and enabling us to think soberly about the road ahead.

Biography. Nello Cristianini is a professor of Artificial Intelligence at the University of Bath. He is the author of the book "The shortcut" (CRC Press) which addresses various open questions about the relation between AI, philosophy of science, and society. In Italy the book is published by Il Mulino, as "La scorciatoia".
